Dear Speaker,

Having been elected President of the Parliamentary Assembly at the opening of the first part-session of the 2026 Ordinary Session, allow me to express my commitment to deepening our close interparliamentary cooperation.

I take on this mandate with deep respect for the trust placed in me.

The priorities of my presidency will focus on promoting freedom of expression and of assembly, as well as on protecting linguistic and cultural minorities. Equal access to education and genuine gender equality will remain central commitments, as democracy cannot be complete without full and equal participation and protection for all.

I will also place strong emphasis on the full implementation of the European Convention on Human Rights and the judgments of the Court, on strengthening democratic resilience against disinformation, corruption and intimidation, and on supporting political prisoners and persecuted democratic actors. At the same time, we must ensure that new challenges - including those linked to artificial intelligence and the digital sphere - are addressed through a firm human-rights-based approach.

Continued support for Ukraine will remain a key priority of my mandate. The war of aggression against Ukraine represents a grave violation of international law, and accountability for serious violations is essential. Ukraine continues to suffer from repeated attacks on civilian and energy infrastructure, leaving many vulnerable people exposed to severe winter conditions. In this context, I have co-initiated the cross-party humanitarian campaign in the Austrian parliament "Stop the Cold – Donate Sleeping Bags", aimed at providing practical winter assistance to civilians most affected by these attacks. You will find more information on this initiative in the files attached to this message.
